CRITERIA FOR E- POSTER SUBMISSION

Respina Hybrid Conference 2022

The 23rd International Meeting on Respiratory Care Indonesia” Respina 2022

Participants:

1. Doctors, Medical Students, Pharmacologists and Biology Scientist.
 2. Poster participants must be registered as "The 23rd International Meeting on Respiratory Care Indonesia" (Respina) 2022 participants.
 3. Deadline registration for poster submission at the latest March 1st, 2022.
 4. Each poster participants must submit 1 (one) abstract from research results or case report in MS Word format and send via email to: respina.scientific@gmail.com no later than March, 31st 2022.
 5. The selected participants must delivered their presentation in English. Poster should be formatted in PDF/JPEG. Each participant individually record their presentation within maximum 7 minutes and 2 minutes for live discussion session with the judges
 6. If the poster participant is not present at the Poster Session, he/she is considered abstain and will not receive the participation certificate.
- a. The abstract must be typed with 1 line spacing distance of the MS Word programs and Arial Font with size 10.
 - f. The abstract and registration form should be sent by email attachment to Respina email: respina.scientific@gmail.com.

2. Poster:

- a. The poster has not been published previously or included in another scientific competitions.
- b. The poster must be typed and printed in English.
- c. The poster must be in A1 size (59.4 cm x 84.1 cm) and in portrait page orientation.
- d. The poster contains no more than 2 images / photos, and 3 tables / graphics.
- e. The Poster consists of:
 - i. Title is written in capital letters and can not use acronym.
 - ii. The author's and institution's names are written under the title.
 - iii. The specified author's names are the ones who contributed to :
 1. The conceptualization, analysis, and data interpretation.
 2. The preparation of the article.
 3. The final approval to be published.The main author's name/the presenter is written on the first order on the authors' names.
 - iv. Content consists of background, case presentation or methods, result (if any), discussion parts and conclusion
 - v. The reference is written based on Vancouver style with the minimum number of literature references is 5 and the maximum number is 15 literatures.
 - vi. The appendix.
- f. The deadline for the poster submission at the latest May 1st 2022.

Assessment Criteria:

1. Topic must be related with theme: **Breathing: The Art of Living, Focus on Optimizing Respiratory Function.**
2. Original work from the participant him/herself.
3. Research methodology
4. Match between the title and the content of the poster.
5. Benefit of the research or the case report.
6. Mastering the content of the poster at the time of the presentation and the discussion session.

Terms of the Preparation:

1. Abstract

- a. The abstract must be typed and printed in English.
- b. The abstract must be written in minimum 100 words and maximum 250 words.
- c. The abstract must include title, author's names, institution's name, background, case presentation or method, result (if any), discussion and conclusion.
- d. The title must be typed entirely in uppercase letters, while the author's names are written in lowercase letters and without the degree, and the presenter's name imprinted on the first order
